

A Little Pollution Adds Up To Big Expens\$e for Your Community and Your Restaurant



Direct costs to your restaurant can occur when grease, garbage and wash water end up in the storm drains.

- **Bad odors** are caused when wash water and waste are poured down the storm drains.
- **Rodents and pests** are attracted to grease and waste around storm drains.
- **Flooding** of property is caused by blocked storm drains.

DO

- ✓ Close trash can lids, doors and drain plugs.
- ✓ Use garbage bags for trash.
- ✓ Clean mats in mop sink or can wash basin.
- ✓ Pour wash water in mop sink or can wash basin.
- ✓ Clean up spills with a spill kit.
- ✓ Dry sweep and spot clean before pressure washing.

DON'T

- ✗ Don't hose off mats outside.
- ✗ Don't pour wash water down storm drains.
- ✗ Don't wash spills down storm drains.
- ✗ Don't pressure wash into storm drains.
- ✗ Don't leave trash or grease containers uncovered.
